



# **DRIVE TRAIL IN KATANNING**

This drive trail gives you a taste the history, culture and industry of Katanning. With a population of 4000 people this inland town is one of the most multicultural regional towns in Australia.

Long before European settlement the area was called KAAT-NYINY, a local Noongar word meaning the head sits here. It was also the junction of three different Aboriginal tribal groups whose boundaries merged at the Kaatanup Springs, an important trading place.


Katanning's primary industries are sheep trading, meat processing, health, education, agribusiness, transport, construction and retail. It is a major service centre for many surrounding towns and a meeting place for business and leisure.

The town is RV friendly with a 48-hour stop on Aberdeen Street, free RV dump point and potable water.
